Hinduism:

Hinduism is the oldest of the world's religions.

It is now practised all over the world but originated in South East Asia.

It is a mix of different beliefs, cultures and traditions dating back over 4000 years.

Hindus recognise one God, Brahman.

The gods of Hinduism are different aspects of Brahman.

The main three aspects (Trimurti) are: Vishnu, Brahma and Shiva The three great goddesses (Tridevi) are:
