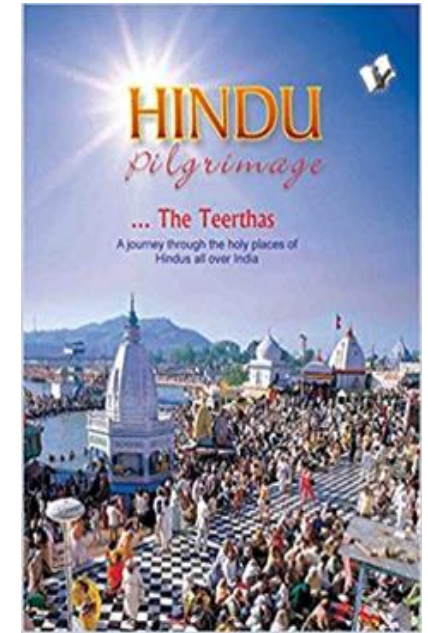


Hinduism
