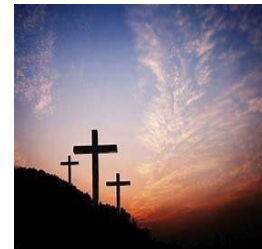
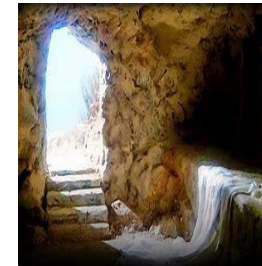
Easter - Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Holy Week, resurrection, tomb, Holy Communion, disciples

The 10 Commandments - Commandments, Old Testament, Torah, Moses

Facts

- **Palm Sunday**. The start of **Holy Week**, when Jesus rode in **Jerusalem** on a donkey. **Palm leaves** were placed on the ground in front of him.
- **Maundy Thursday**. Jesus had the **Last Supper** with his **disciples** and shared bread and wine with them. **Holy Communion** represents this meal.
- **Good Friday**. When Jesus died on the **cross**. Christians believe Jesus died for the sins of others. He was placed in a stone **tomb**.
- **Easter Sunday**. The **resurrection** of Jesus. Christians believe this symbolises the promise of eternal life in heaven.
- The 10 **Commandments** are God's rules for living and Christians (and Jews) believe them to be rules that they are commanded to follow.
- The **Torah** contains part of the **Old Testament**.
