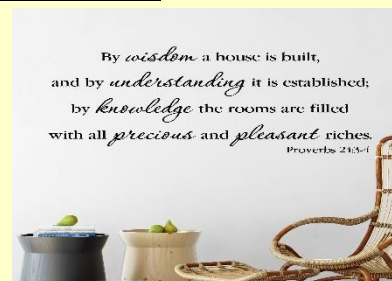
Facts

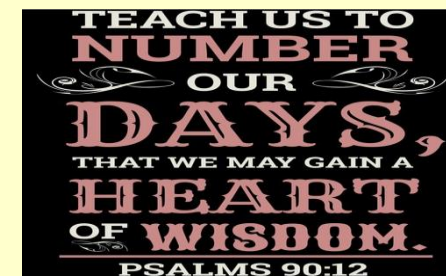
- Art and music are two ways in which people express the Christian festival of Christmas.
