Facts

- **Relief printing** is a **process** consisting of cutting or etching a **printing** surface in such a way that all that remains of the original surface is the design to be **printed**.
- **Dip Dyeing Fabric** involves submerging your **fabric** into a bucket or vat of **dye** to make it a different colour.
- Batik is an Indonesian technique of wax-resist dyeing applied to whole cloth. This technique originated from Java, Indonesia. Batik is made either by drawing dots and lines of the resist with a spouted tool called a tjanting.
